### II. Director's Report—John Kenny

- Upgrades—

  - Softball bleachers upgrade

#### Revenue

- 60 banner invoices were sent the first week of October (most on Oct 2) via Square Pay
- 23 sponsors have paid so far (most via Square Pay, some by check, one company paid in the form of gift cards\* to their business establishment)
- \$13,140 in revenue collected so far.
- Expected revenue: \$33,100 (including gift card value)

\*30 \$25 gift cards were sent via email. They are currently residing in a folder in the Madison Banner email account. I informed Mr. Kenny that they are there and I am waiting to be told what to do with them. The idea is that they will be used for staff or some kind of school promotion.
